

# Vote Now For LTU's Trustees

There is going to be a ballot of members of the Lloyds TSB Offshore Banking Pension Scheme because more nominations were received than vacancies for the position of Trustee Director. Two Director positions are due for re-election this year for a period of six years. Staff entitled to vote should receive a voting form from the Electoral Reform Society in the next few days. This will include details of candidates and information on the voting procedure.

## Important To Members

Giving members some control over how their pension fund is run is a critical objective for LTU and experience has shown that Member Nominated Trustees are most effective where they are not isolated individuals but have the resources and backing of a strong trade union.

## Vote For LTU's Nominations

LTU's Executive Committee will be asking members to support the nomination of two members of the scheme:

- James Wood (Active Staff) - Jim has served on the Union's Offshore Banking Committee and Negotiating Team for over 13 years. In addition to this, Jim is also LTU's Joint Accredited Staff Representative for the Isle of Man, and is the Offshore Banking delegate to General Council.
- Davinia Smith (Active) - Davinia, who is a Manager in Hill Samuel looking after Corporate Trustee Services, has served on the Union's Offshore Banking Committee for over 10 years.

Eligible staff will have one vote for each of the two vacancies and we urge all members to support LTU by voting for the election of our two nominations onto the Board of Trustees. Only a strong LTU presence on the Trustee Board will ensure that the interests of both staff and pensioners are protected both now and in the future.
