Vote Now For LTU's Trustees

There is going to be a ballot of members of the Lloyds TSB No 1 and No 2 Pension Schemes because more nominations were received than vacancies for the position of Trustee Director. Three Director positions are due for re-election this year. Staff entitled to vote should receive a voting paper from the Electoral Reform Society in the next few days. This will include a list of candidates and information on the voting procedure.

Important To Members

Giving members some control over how their pension fund is run is a critical objective for LTU and experience has shown that Member Nominated Trustees are most effective where they are not isolated individuals but have the resources and backing of a strong trade union.

Vote For LTU's Nominations

LTU's Executive Committee will be asking members to support the nomination of two members of the scheme as follows:

No 1 (Lloyd Bank) Pension Scheme

- **Keith Cullup (Pensioner)** - Keith works for the Union as a Consultant in individual case representation and was previously Senior Manager at Slough Central until his retirement. He was Chairman of the Union and a member of the Executive Committee for many years.

No 2 (TSB Bank) Pension Scheme

- **Richard Smith (Active Staff)** - Richard has been a key member of the Union's Salesforce Negotiating Committee for 9 years. Richard's been in the Bank for 20 years

Richard has said that "For many staff both past and present the pension scheme is the most important benefit they receive.....and ensuring that it is properly managed for the future will be one of my top priorities should I be elected to the Trustee Board."

Eligible staff will have one vote for each of the vacancies and we urge all members to support LTU by voting for the election of our two nominations onto the Board of Trustees. Only a strong LTU presence on the Trustee Board will ensure that the interests of both staff and pensioners are protected both now and in the future.
